# Notice for election of office bearers and members of Executive Committee, 2020-24

Notice is hereby given to all affiliated State/UT Associations/Units of Net-ball Federation of India for the conduct of the election to the Office Bearers and Executive Committee members of the Netball Federation of India, as per the following schedule and in accordance with the Constitution of the Netball Federation of India (copy of the said Constitution may be seen from the website of the NFI <a href="www.netballindia.in">www.netballindia.in</a>) and National Sports Development Code and rules, regulations and model election guidelines evolved by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India (copy of the said guidelines may be seen from the website of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India <a href="http://yas.nic.in/sports/national-sports-development-code-india-2011">http://yas.nic.in/sports/national-sports-development-code-india-2011</a>).

2. (a) As per Articles 4(d) and 4(g) of the Constitution of the Netball Federation of India (hereinafter referred to as 'NFI'), the Executive Committee of NFI, shall consist

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of 18 (eighteen) Office Bearers and 10 (ten) Executive Members elected by the General Council of NFL

(b) The 28 (twenty-eight) Office Bearers shall be as follows:-

(i)	President 1	(one)
(ii)	Sr. Vice-President 1	(one)
(iii)	Vice-Presidents 7	(seven)
(iv)	Hon. Secretary General 1	(one)
(v)	Hon. Treasurer 1	(one)
(vi)	Associate Secretaries 7	(seven)
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(vii) Executive Members 10 (Ten)

- 3. Election shall be held at the General Council Meeting (GM) strictly in accordance with the Constitution of the Netball Federation of India and National Sports Development Code and rules, regulations and model election guidelines issued by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India
- Office Bearers and members of Executive Committee of NFI shall be elected by secret ballot.
- 5. As per the Clause 4 and Sub Clauses 1 to 4 of model elections guidelines of Sports code ,2011, each Affiliated Association shall have 2(two) votes at the elections of the Office bearers and Executive members, for the purpose abovementioned election , each Affiliated Association of the States/UT's shall be represented by the two Representatives duly authorized jointly by the President and Secretary General/Secretary of the Affiliated Association on its letter head. Any Intimation received thereafter i.e. the Last date and the time fixed for intimation shall be permitted only with the Approval of the President of the NFI; however , in case the President/Secretary General / Secretary of the Affiliated Associations of the States /UT's nominates different Names of persons ,the persons authorized by the President of State affiliated association shall be deemed to be authorized person , irrespective of the date . Any such Authorization which is not signed jointly by the President / Secretary General / Secretary of the Association shall not be taken into account for the purpose of the preparation of the Electoral Collage .

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- 7. The nomination of a candidate for election as office bearers or a member of Executive Committee shall be proposed by one of the representatives of member states/Union Territories whose name is included in the Electoral College list in Form 1 and also subscribed by 1 (one) such representative as seconder.
- 8. Each candidate shall be entitled to be nominated by not more than 2 (two) nomination papers.
- 9. Each nomination paper shall be delivered Personally to the Returning Officer/ARO in person or through Online mode via Video conferencing as per the Schedule mentioned above. The facility for delivering nomination paper by the candidate himself/herself in person to the R.O/ARO shall be for those members who reside in Delhi/NCR and any other member who resides outside Delhi/NCR and who wish to file nomination in person should file nomination on fixed date and time and for delivering of the nomination through online via Video Conferencing shall be available for those who reside outside Delhi/NCR. Submission of Online nomination via Video Conferencing shall be available as a special case because of inter State travel restrictions and Lockdown in Some states/UTs due to COVID-19 pandemic.
- 10. No person shall be eligible to nominate more than one candidate for the same post, either as proposer or seconder; and, if he so does, his/her signature on the nomination paper delivered second in point of time to the returning officer shall be deemed to be inoperative.
- 11. No person shall be permitted to withdraw his/her name as proposer/seconder, once the nomination paper subscribed by him/her has been delivered to returning officer.
- 12. At the scrutiny of nominations, each candidate or one of his/her authorized representative shall have the right to be present in person or through online via

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video conferencing and raise any objection in relation to nominations of the candidate for the post for which he/she has filed his/her nomination.

- 13. On the day of scrutiny, the Returning Officer in his Office shall scrutinise each nomination paper, one by one, received by him in person or through online via Video Conferencing and determine its validity or otherwise.
- 14. At the scrutiny of nominations, each candidate or one of his/her authorised representative shall have the right to be present in person or via Video Conferencing and raise any objection in relation to nomination of a candidate for the post for which he/she has filed his/her nomination. As soon as may be after the scrutiny of all nomination papers has been completed by him, the Returning Officer/ARO shall prepare a list of validly nominated candidates in Form 4. and post it on the website of NFI; Contesting Candidates can take a copy from the Returning Officer.
- 15. Each candidate whose nomination has been found valid on scrutiny, shall be entitled to withdraw his/her candidature in person or through Online via Video Conferencing From 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 (Friday) 14<sup>th</sup> August 2020 (Saturday) and 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2020 (Monday) between 2.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m.
- 16. Notice of withdrawal of candidature shall be submitted in Form 5,in person or Through Online via Video Conferencing either by the candidate himself/herself or by a person duly authorized by him/her in writing.
- 17. Notice of withdrawal of candidature shall be final and shall not be allowed to be cancelled.
- 18. The Returning Officer shall accept the notice of withdrawal if he is satisfied as to the genuineness of the notice.
- 19. As soon as may be after the withdrawal of nominations, the Returning Officer shall prepare the final list of contesting candidates in Form-6, display a copy of the said list in conspicuous place in his office and websites of NFI. And also

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furnish a copy of the same to each of the candidates/their authorized representatives, if they so demand.

- 20. The names of the contesting candidates in Form 6 shall be arranged, for each post, in alphabetical order according to English alphabets.
- Where the number of contesting candidates for any post, in Form 6 is equal to the number of posts to be filled, all such contesting candidates shall be deemed to be duly elected unopposed to those posts, and it shall not be necessary to take a poll for election to such post.
- 22. Where the number of contesting candidates for any post, in Form 6 is more than the number of posts to be filled, a poll shall be taken by secret ballot for those posts remaining unfilled.
- 23. The ballot papers for these posts remaining unfilled shall be in Form 7 to Form 13 to be made individually for each post.
- 24. The names of contesting candidates on the ballot papers shall appear in the same order as in Form 6.
- 25. Each contesting candidate can nominate one person, (If he/ she so desires), only from amongst the list of Authorized Representatives (Form 1), to be present at the Poll (Polling station).
- 26. At the poll, each authorized representatives of Affiliated Association and whose name is included in the Electoral College list in Form 1, shall be entitled to
  - (i) cast one vote for each of the posts remaining unfilled, where only one such seat is to be filled;
  - (ii) cast as many votes as are the no. of seats to be filled for any post, where more than one seat is to be filled.

Explanation: It is hereby clarified that for the purpose of filling 7 (seven) seats of Vice-Presidents, each voter can cast upto 7 (seven) votes, and, like-wise, for 7 (seven) seats of Associate Secretaries, and 10 (ten) seats of Members of Executive Committee, he/she can cast 7 (seven) and 10 (ten) votes respectively for the above

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mentioned 7 (seven) seats of Associate Secretaries and 10 (ten) seats of Members of Executive Committee.

- 27. In case any voter casts his/her vote for more than the candidate, or candidates to be elected from any post, his/her vote for that post shall be invalid.
- 28. Each voter shall be required, before he is supplied with a Ballot paper, to give his/her signature on the authenticated copy of the Electoral College list in Form I used by the Returning Officer for taking the poll.
- 29. The voter shall record his/her vote on the ballot paper in secrecy in a voting compartment specially provided for the purpose at the polling station.
- 30. The voter shall record his/her vote on the ballot paper by placing a tick mark (√) against the name of the candidate of his/her choice, and any other mark, like (x) etc. or word, placed on the ballot paper by him/her shall render the ballot paper liable to rejection.
- 31. The tick mark ( $\sqrt{}$ ) to indicate the vote shall be placed by the voter only by means of article specifically provided for the purpose by the Returning Officer, and a ballot paper marked otherwise by means of any pen, ball point pen, etc. by the voter shall render the ballot paper liable to rejection.
- 32. The ballot paper marked by a voter shall be deposited by him/her in a ballot box specially prepared and sealed by the Returning Officer and placed at such a conspicuous place in the polling station that it shall be constantly visible to all present in the polling station.
- 33. The Returning Officer shall close the poll at the appointed hour; however, all those voters who are present at the polling station at the appointed closing hour shall be entitled to vote even if the poll proceedings have to be continued for some more time.
- 34. After all the voters, referred to above, have voted, the Returning Officer shall close the ballot box and shall not permit thereafter any person to vote.

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- 35. The Returning Officer shall take up the counting of votes as soon as may be after the polling is closed.
- 36. Each contesting candidate can nominate one authorized representative and he/she shall be entitled to be present at the place of counting of votes.
- 37. The Returning Officer shall take up the counting of votes, post-wise.
- 38. Each ballot paper on which a vote has been recorded, as mentioned above, shall be treated as one vote for the candidate for whom it has been validly marked; and if any ballot paper has been marked in violation of any of the aforesaid provisions shall be rejected by the Returning Officer.
- 39. The votes validly cast for each of the contesting candidates shall be counted post-wise, and recorded in the descending order of the votes so cast for each candidate in Form 14.
- 40. The Returning Officer shall thereafter ascertain the result of counting and the candidates who have secured the maximum no. of votes in the said descending order, post-wise, equal to the no. of seats to be filled for each post, shall be deemed to have been duly elected to those posts.
- 41. The names of contesting candidates who shall be deemed to have been elected at the election, as per mentioned above, shall be declared as having been duly elected to their respective posts, by the Returning Officer at the General Meeting (GM) in the Form 15.
- 42. If any person/affiliated association have any complaint, regarding this election, may contact to any of the member of the Election Committee or can give in writing in the name of Returning Officer or Assistant Returning Officers or can send it through email of the Election Committee (nfielections2020@gmail.com).
- 43. The venue for all activities mentioned in Item Nos. 1 to 9 in the Schedule above, shall be the Office of the Election Committee, 487/5,1st Floor Peeragarhi Chowk, New Delhi 110087

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- 44. This may kindly be noted that all disputes are subject to the jurisdiction of the courts of Delhi only.
